Junee Licorice and Chocolate Factory

On Thursday, 14 November, the students in Year 3-6 travelled by bus to Junee to visit the Junee Licorice and Chocolate Factory with Mrs Glyde and Mr Brown. It is located at the restored Junee Flour Mill, a historically rich landmark in the town. The Factory produces a vast range of certified organic confectionaries.

The students had a guided tour of the factory and watched the production of licorice and chocolate coating of all organic products. They learned about the historic Junee Flour Mill, built in 1935, as well as how Green Grove Organics-Junee Licorice and Chocolate Factory came to be. They loved getting to sample bits and pieces throughout the factory tour! Vertical licorice bowling was an interesting experience!

The class favourite was definitely the "hands on" chocolate experience of making a GIANT chocolate Freckle!
