Impetigo (School Sores)

Time from exposure to illness

1 to 3 days.

Symptoms

Small red spots change into blisters that fill up with pus and become crusted; usually on the face, hands or scalp.

Do I need to keep my child home?

Yes, until antibiotic treatment starts. Sores should be covered with watertight dressings.

How can I prevent spread?

Careful hand washing.

Influenza

Time from exposure to illness

1 to 3 days.

Symptoms

Sudden onset fever, runny nose, sore throat, cough, muscle aches and headaches.

Do I need to keep my child home?

Yes, until they look and feel better.

How can I prevent spread?

Careful hand washing, especially after coughing, sneezing or wiping your nose. Immunization, is recommended for children with chronic illnesses.
