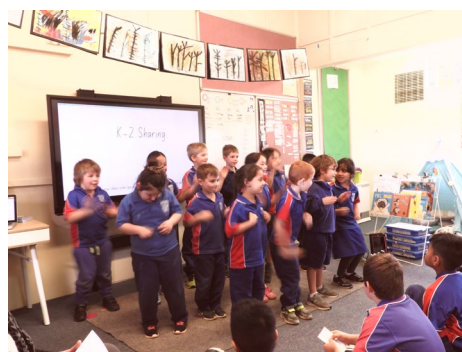
P&C News
