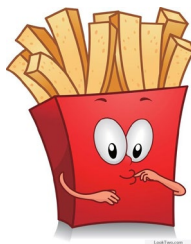

The SRC are asking for any old trucks you may have in the cupboard. Some extras in the sandpit would be very welcome,

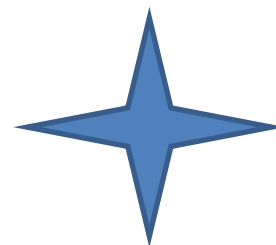
On Friday 27th of September, there will be a talent quest. We invite parents and family members to come and watch.

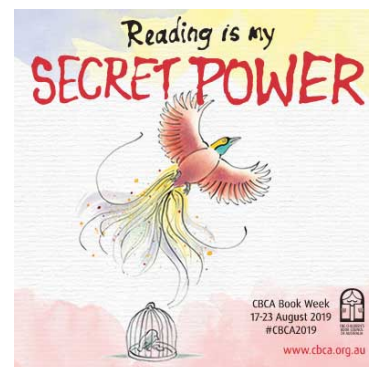
