What is it? Day Camp is a program for all boys and girls in school Years 3-6. It is 3 days filled with exciting times of discovery and adventure in the beautiful outdoors. It has been run in bushland surrounding Griffith since the 1980's to build a sense of community and resilience in our community and families. Griffith Day Camp is run by Fusion Australia in conjunction with the Griffith Christian Churches Association. Christian principles and teaching is included in this camp which is open to people of all cultures, backgrounds and beliefs.

Each day consists of teaching, songs, craft, sports, activities, games, shelter building, camp fires, cooking, friendship and teamwork. The camp runs from 9am till 4pm for three days, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. We will only receive registrations for the whole camp. Campers are supplied with morning & afternoon tea and will participate in cooking their lunches (supplied). On the Thursday afternoon from 3.30-4.30pm families are invited to join in the afternoon tea to see the children's work.

Cost

\$60.00 1 Child - entire camp
\$45.00 each for additional children in the same family
If cost is genuinely a problem please contact us.

Supervision

Day Campers will be organised into small groups of 5 to 8 kids with a leader and assistant leader. We will have first aid officers on site and adult leaders on each of the various activities as well as coordinators around the site.

Equipment to BRING:

Campers must wear closed in shoes, have a hat, drink bottle and apply sunscreen. A plate for hot food is recommended. Some equipment is provided including adventure equipment, cooking gear, billys, craft materials etc.



Travel

Parents/guardians - you are responsible for the drop off and pick up of your own children to and from the site. If this is a problem for you (i.e. no car) let us know and we will attempt to arrange other transportation for your children.

Food



There will be cooking fires for lunches and the **food will be provided**. Please bring a water bottle that can be refilled (water & cordial supplied). Morning and Afternoon Tea is provided during the event but campers can bring marshmallows for the campfire.
