Principal's Message

With the learning needs of our students the focus of decision making, the 2021 staffing arrangements have been finalized. A note was sent home to all families last week informing them of the roles and responsibilities of our 2021 staff. We have a new teacher, Mrs. Natasha Long and a new SLSO, Juanita Garcia, joining us next year. They come highly recommended and with valuable skills which will benefit our students and Tharbogang Public School.

Presentation Day

Our end of year presentations will be very different this year due to current COVID-19 guidelines. We will be holding a Presentation of Awards Day, on school grounds, at 10am on Wednesday, 9th December. Staff had originally planned to do a Virtual Presentation of Book Awards Day via Zoom but in light of recent easing of the COVID-19 restrictions, parents will now be able to attend. Very strict COVID Safety Plans however will be in place and the guidelines must be adhered to.

Due to the physically distancing restrictions of 4 square metres per person, the school can only accommodate **TWO ADULTS PER FAMILY** (in addition to students and staff). Each family will be allocated 2 tickets which need to be claimed at the front office, indicating the names of those attending. All visitors must sign the external visitors form on entering school grounds before the ceremony.

The Presentation of Book Awards to students will remain the same as in previous years. However, there will be no singing or other performances due to the COVID restrictions – Group singing, chanting and rapping can only have a maximum of 5 and schools must not have multiple groups of 5 in the same space. Whole school singing and dancing is what we have always done.
