Ten Pin Bowling is being held on Fridays from 12.30-1.30pm. The dates are:

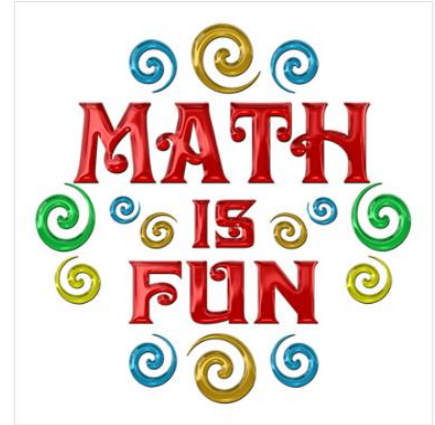

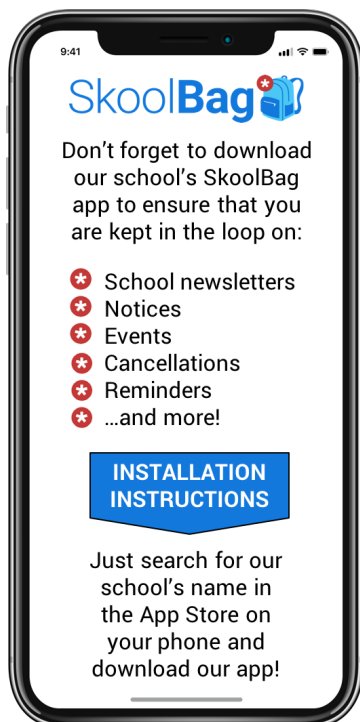
