Ten Pin Bowling

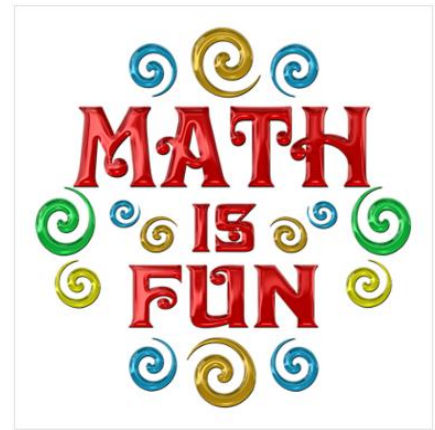
Ten Pin Bowling is being held on Fridays from 12.30-1.30pm. The dates are:

Assembling our 2019 Year Book is nearly complete. Please place your order at the school office. The Year Book is available at a cost of \$10.

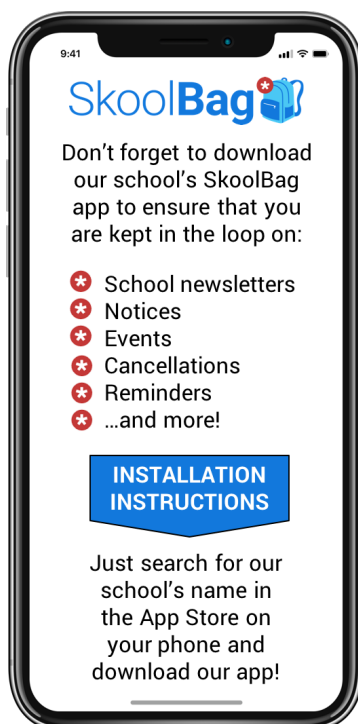
School Photos
