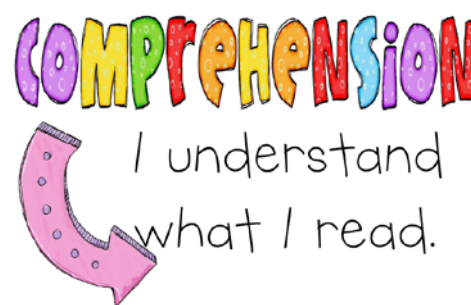

Years 3-6 News

English- We will be focusing on Reading Comprehension strategies including Inferring and Summarising to help student make meaning from a variety of texts. The class will also continue writing recounts of events held at TPS throughout the year. They will be thinking imaginatively, creatively and interpretively about information, ideas and texts when responding to and composing texts. They will discuss how authors and illustrators make stories exciting, moving and absorbing and hold a readers interest by using various techniques, for example, character development and plot tension.



Maths- Whole Number: Stage 2 students will recognise, model, represent and order numbers to at least 10,000. They will represent numbers up to four digits using objects, numerals and digital displays, making the largest and smallest number from 4 given numbers. They will identify the number before and after given numbers, count forwards and backwards by tens and hundreds, and arrange numbers of up to 4 digits in ascending and descending order



Stage 3 will recognise, represent and order numbers to at least tens of millions. They will apply an understanding of place value and the role of zero to read and write numbers of any size. They will state the place value of digits in numbers, arrange numbers of any size in ascending and descending order and record numbers using expanded notation. The whole class will be using the terms and symbols for 'less than' and 'greater than' to show the relationship between two numbers.

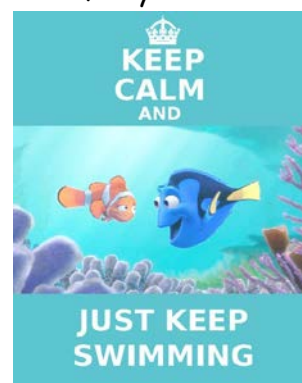
Creative Arts- Our class will be involved in a variety of visual art, drama, singing and dancing activities, planning and performing for an audience.



Science - Students will be supported to plan and conduct an investigation of whether Eucalyptus oil might help the plant defend itself against other living things. They will discuss ideas about why eucalypts produce oil then plan and conduct an investigation. The following week, students will present the results of the investigation and reflect on it and ideas about life cycles and survival.

PDHPE- Swimming will be the sport program for term 4 every Wednesday at 11am, with morning fitness focusing on a variety of ball skills (catching, passing, kicking, fielding).

K-2 News

This week we have a fairly normal week with swimming on Wednesday and transition on Thursday although I will be attending Best Start Training in Griffith on Thursday. Alana Primrose will be having the class as normal.

A big thank you to all the parents and families that's attended our K-2 assembly on Friday it was lovely to see you all. Our next assembly will be in week 6 and will be a 3-6 assembly.

This past week we have been looking at adding length to our sentences by using adjectives and adverbs. We have also been writing recounts about our excursion to Altina Zoo. We have also engaged in procedure 3 reads this week with some of the student's choices for the stories.

In math, kindergarten have been looking at number lines for addition and subtraction and using tally marks to represent numbers 0-20. Stage 1 have been engaging in division and number patterns, they have enjoyed using concrete materials as well using mental strategies to see the relationship between addition and subtraction and division and multiplication.

Last week we started an artist study on Henri Matisse and enjoyed creating art with scissors. Our masterpieces each tell a story!
