Stage 1 have continued looking at division and multiplication this past week and are beginning to explore the connection they have with one another. Kindergarten have been exploring number lines and using them to solve addition and subtraction questions!

We have been busy throughout Literacy time with our writing improving as we add adjectives and adverbs to our simple and compunction sentences. We always love illustrating our writing. If you get the chance you are more than welcome to see some 'wow writing' which is displayed in our room.
